1. Preamble

LEAD College is committed to promoting academic excellence, diversity, and global exposure by providing financial support to deserving students. This Scholarship Policy aims to recognize merit, support students financially, and attract international talent.

2. Objectives

- To reward holistic excellence in Academic, Leadership, Career Development, and Research.
- To provide financial assistance to deserving students
- To promote inclusivity and diversity
- To attract international (foreign) students

3. Scope

This policy applies to:

- All eligible domestic students enrolled in various programs
- All foreign (international) students admitted to the institution

4. Categories of Scholarships

4.1 Full Fees Waiver (Merit Based)

- **Number of Scholarships:** 8 students
- **Benefit:** 100% waiver of the entire fees
- **Duration:** Per semester, subject to renewal conditions

4.2 Full Tuition Fee Waiver (Merit-Based)

- **Number of Scholarships:** 10 students
- **Benefit:** 100% waiver of tuition fees
- **Duration:** Per semester, subject to renewal conditions

4.3 Partial Tuition Fee Waiver – Category A

- **Number of Scholarships:** 100 students
- **Benefit:** ₹50,000 tuition fee waiver per semester
- **Duration:** Per semester, subject to renewal conditions

4.8 Partial Tuition Fee Waiver – Category B

- **Number of Scholarships:** 100 students
- **Benefit:** ₹25,000 tuition fee waiver per semester
- **Duration:** Per semester, subject to renewal conditions

4.9 Foreign Student Scholarship

- **Eligibility:** All admitted foreign (international) students
- **Benefit:** 100% tuition fee waiver
- **Duration:** Applicable per semester, subject to institutional regulations

5. Eligibility Criteria

5.1 For Domestic Students

Students must:

- Meet academic and non academic merit criteria (LEAD Score) set by the institution
- Maintain required attendance
- Demonstrate good conduct and discipline
- Fulfil any additional criteria (Special achievements, LOT/Club. Career development, research etc)

5.2 For Foreign Students

- Must be officially admitted as an international student
- Must comply with visa and regulatory requirements
- Must maintain academic performance and discipline standards

6. Selection Process

- Scholarships will be awarded based on merit and defined criteria
- A Scholarship Committee will evaluate and approve candidates
- The committee's decision shall be final

7. Renewal Conditions

All scholarships are subject to renewal each semester based on:

- Minimum academic performance
- Required attendance
- Satisfactory conduct
- Compliance with institutional rules

Failure to meet conditions may lead to withdrawal of the scholarship.

8. General Conditions

- Scholarships apply only to tuition fees
- Only one scholarship can be availed at a time
- Scholarships are non-transferable
- Any false information will result in cancellation
- The institution reserves the right to revise the policy

9. Monitoring and Review

- Periodic review by the Scholarship Committee
- Performance tracking of beneficiaries
- Adjustments based on institutional policies

10. Grievance Redressal

- Students may submit grievances to the designated committee
- Issues will be addressed transparently and promptly

11. Policy Review

- The policy will be reviewed periodically
- Amendments will be made with governing body approval
